BOONE JUNIOR COLLEGE

Fifteen years ago the Boone Junior College was founded, a college fully accredited by the Iowa Inter-Collegiate Committee and the State Department of Education. Dean Thorngren, Miss Grace Slosson, Miss Ethel Whitney, Mr. Bechtel, and Mr. H. L. Cunningham may be called charter members of the junior college faculty.

Unconditional admission to junior college is granted all students who are graduates of an accredited four-year high school, and whose credits are acceptable for the Liberal Arts Course at the University of Iowa.

The junior college classes are organized with regular officers. These officers, Bill Kading, president; Dayle Walker, vice-president; Eunice Anderson, secretary-treasurer, and Bob Kelly, program chairman, work with the Dean in arranging convocations, social affairs, and other college activities.

Among the extra-curricular activities are: Mixed Chorus, "Y Co-eds," Dramatic Club, and Basketball.
