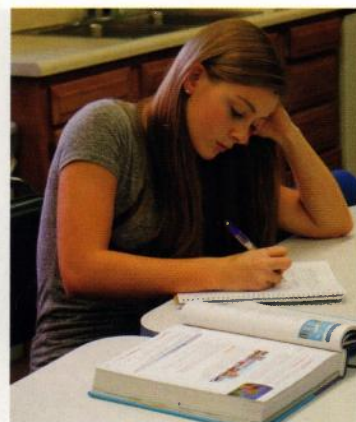
Virtual Reality Students Work Hard

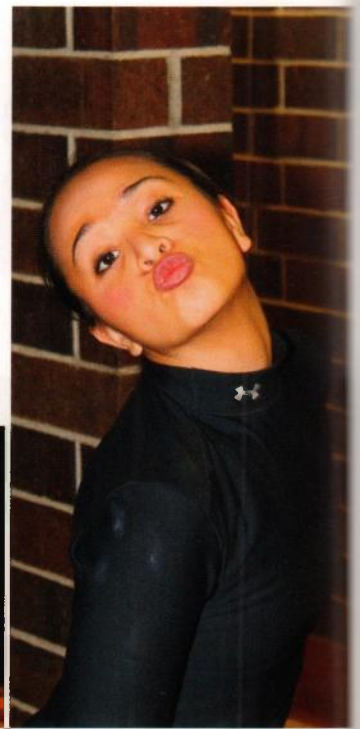

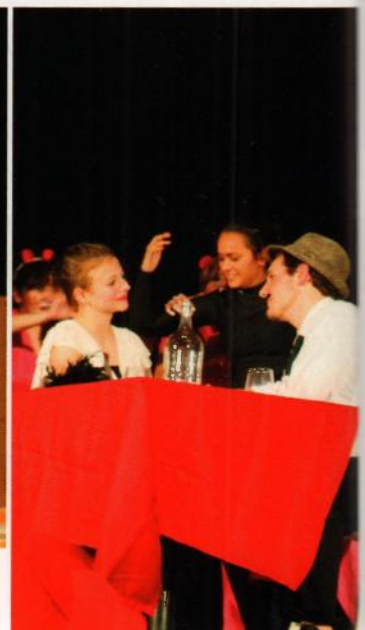

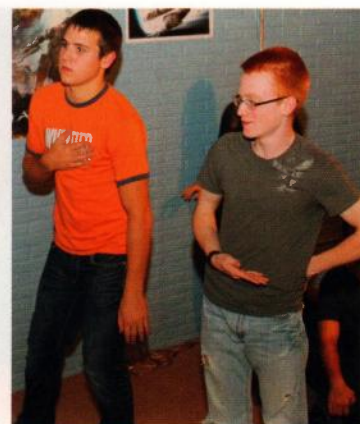

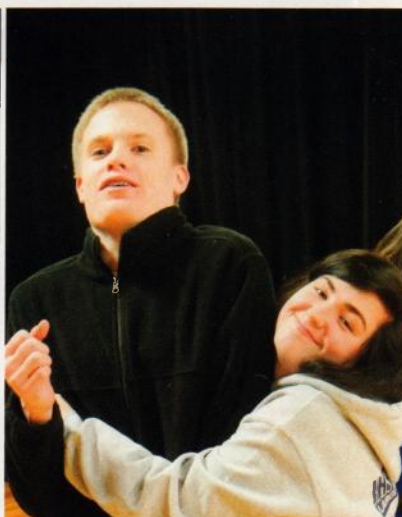

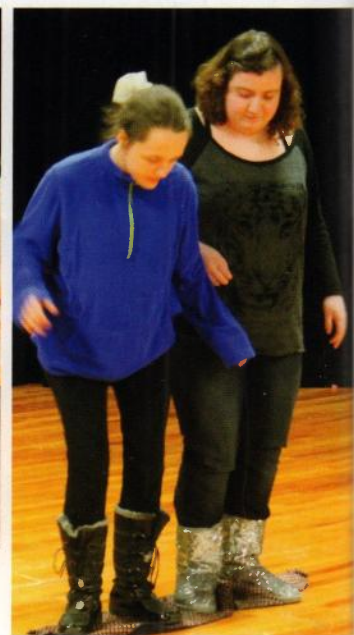

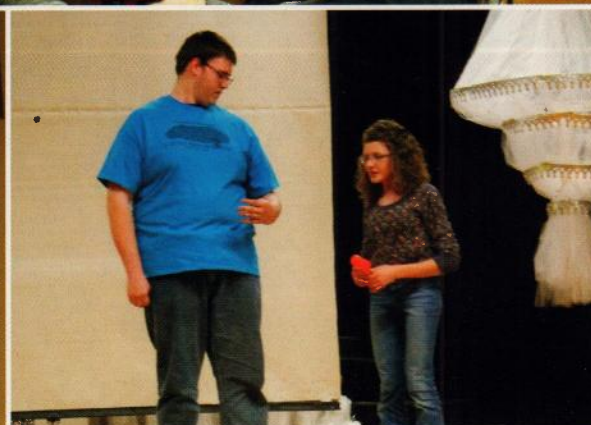
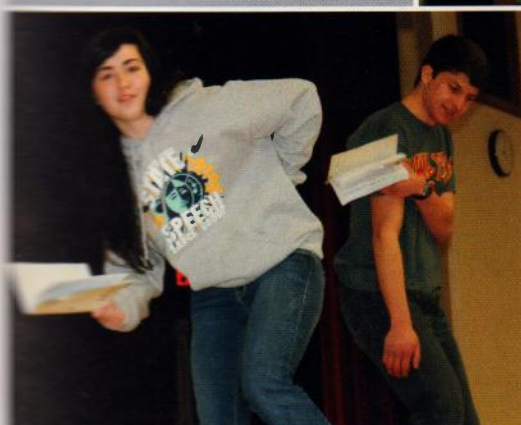

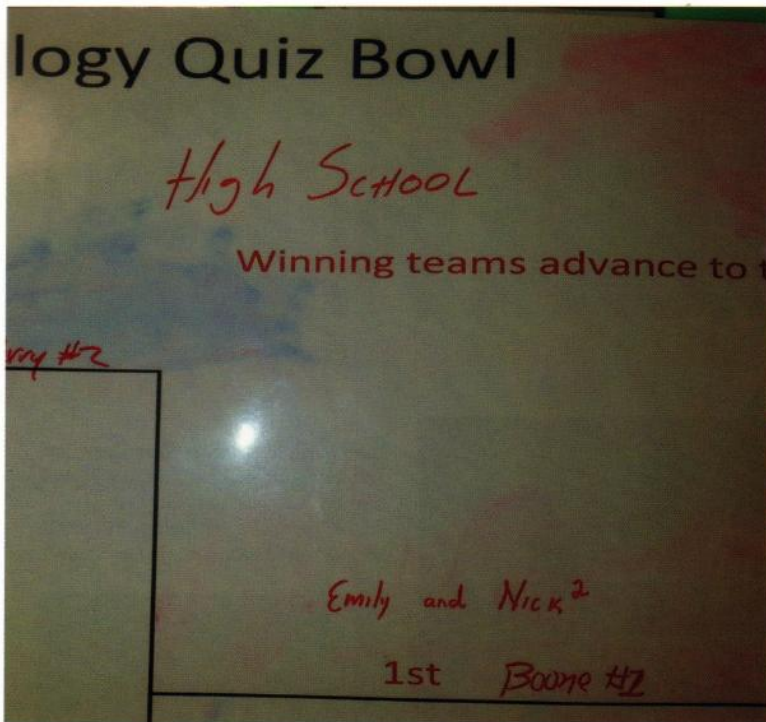

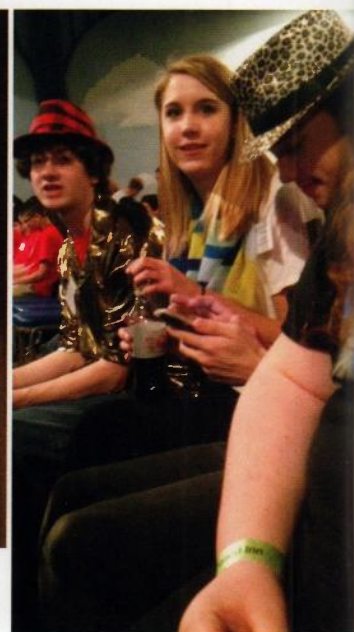

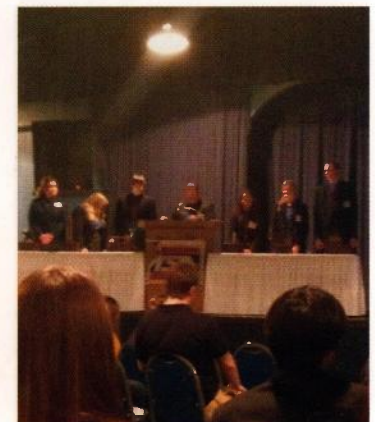


TSA

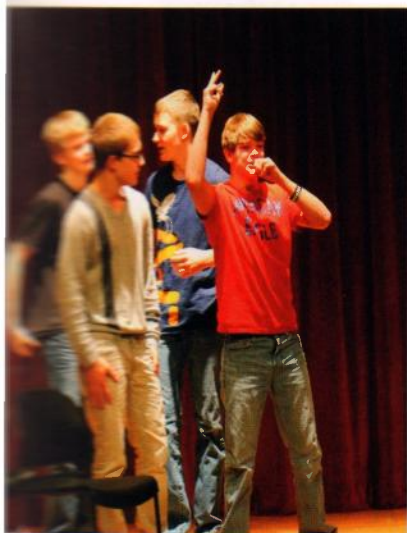

Large Group Speech

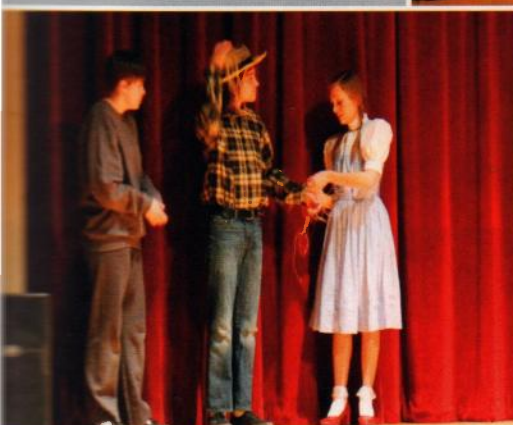

Individual Speech Team

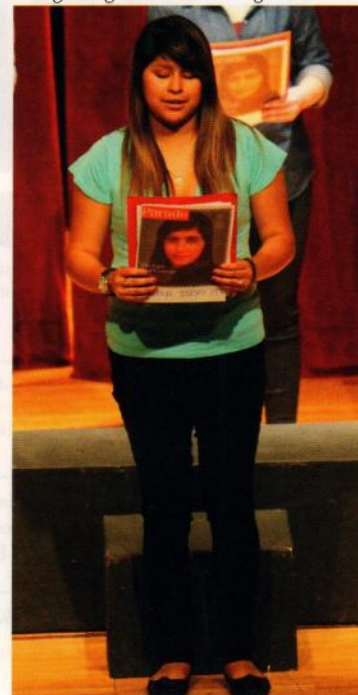

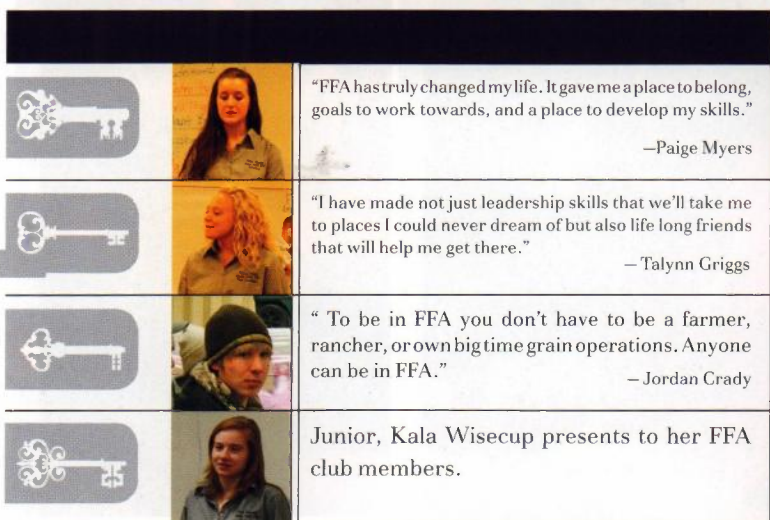
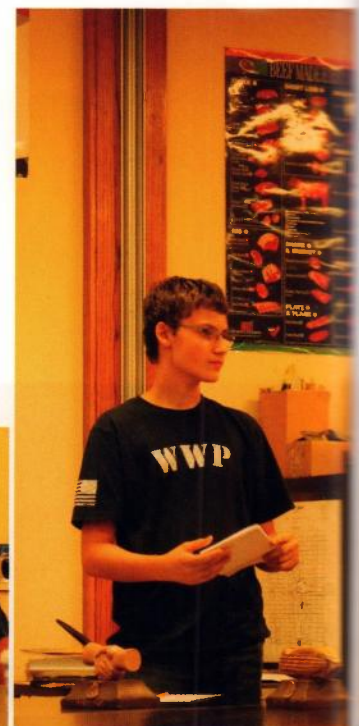

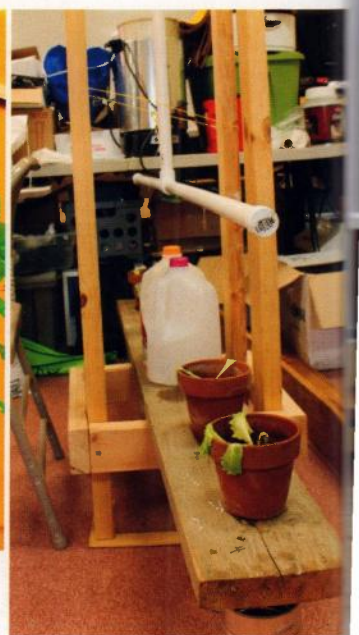

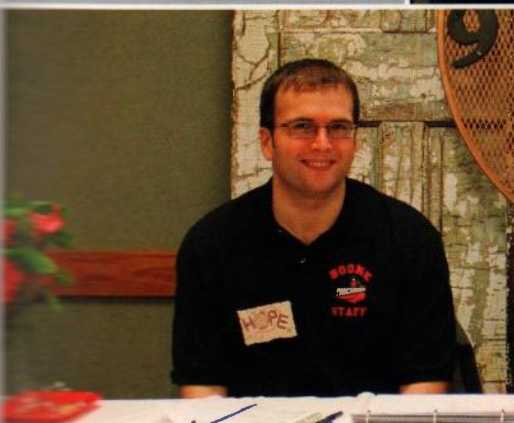

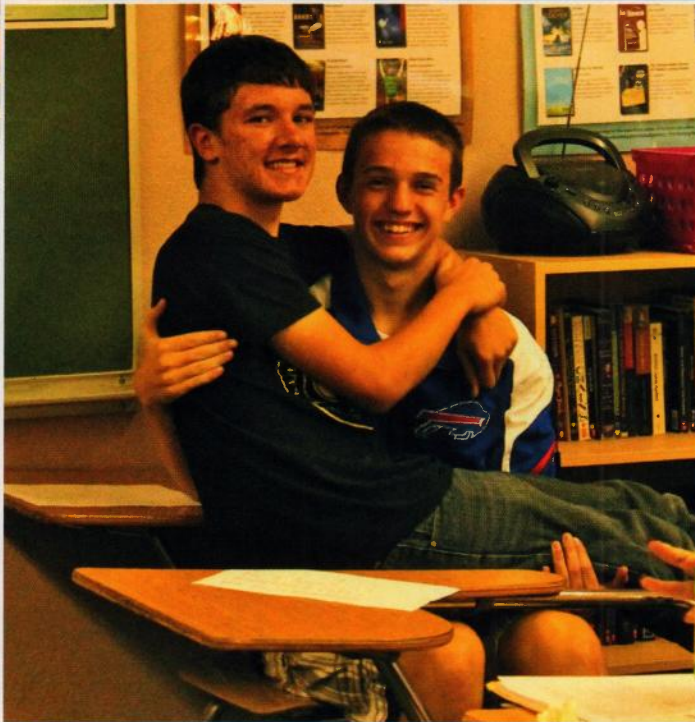
