Apparently the story originated from the incident last night when the police were called to quell a disturbance at Seventh and Story streets where a large group was making a lot of noise.

Two of the boys were taken to the station and then released. They appeared in the mayor's court this morning but no charges were brought against them.

The boy who was reportedly "sapped" with a club

explained that there was quite a bit of excitement and that he was hit across the mouth once but did not think that a club was used on him.

A large number of students went to the city hall and asked for the release of the boys and from this incident the story has grown until according to some rumors the youths were practically running the police station and threatening to do things to the cops if the boys were not released.

According to police Chief Jack Berry, everybody was pretty much excited and confused and that in spite of the talk today there was not an awful lot going on last night.

Nazis shoot American prisoners

(UP) — Tight-lipped, furious Yanks today checked bodies for identification in a field a few miles from Malmédy, Belgium, where on or about Dec. 18 more than 100 American soldiers taken prisoner in the start of the Nazi counter-offensive were shot by their captors.

A few of the men made good an escape and told the dramatic story when they reached the American lines. Now pushing the Germans back to their homeland, U.S. Infantrymen retook the field where their buddies were killed.

Allied warplanes caught 3,000 German vehicles, the bulk of transport of an entire army, in an attempt sneakaway from the Ardennes salient through the Siegfried line to the Rhine, and tore them to pieces today in a ruinous day-long attack.

The Nazis had waited too long to run the gauntlet down the snow drifted escape roads and were caught on two highways in concentrations so thick that the Allied pilots said afterwards "we couldn't miss."
