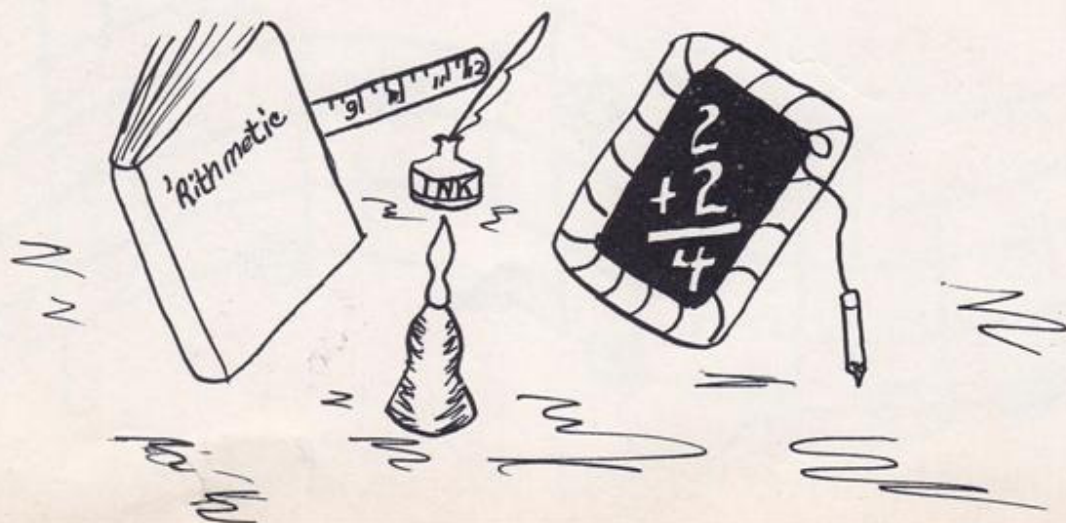

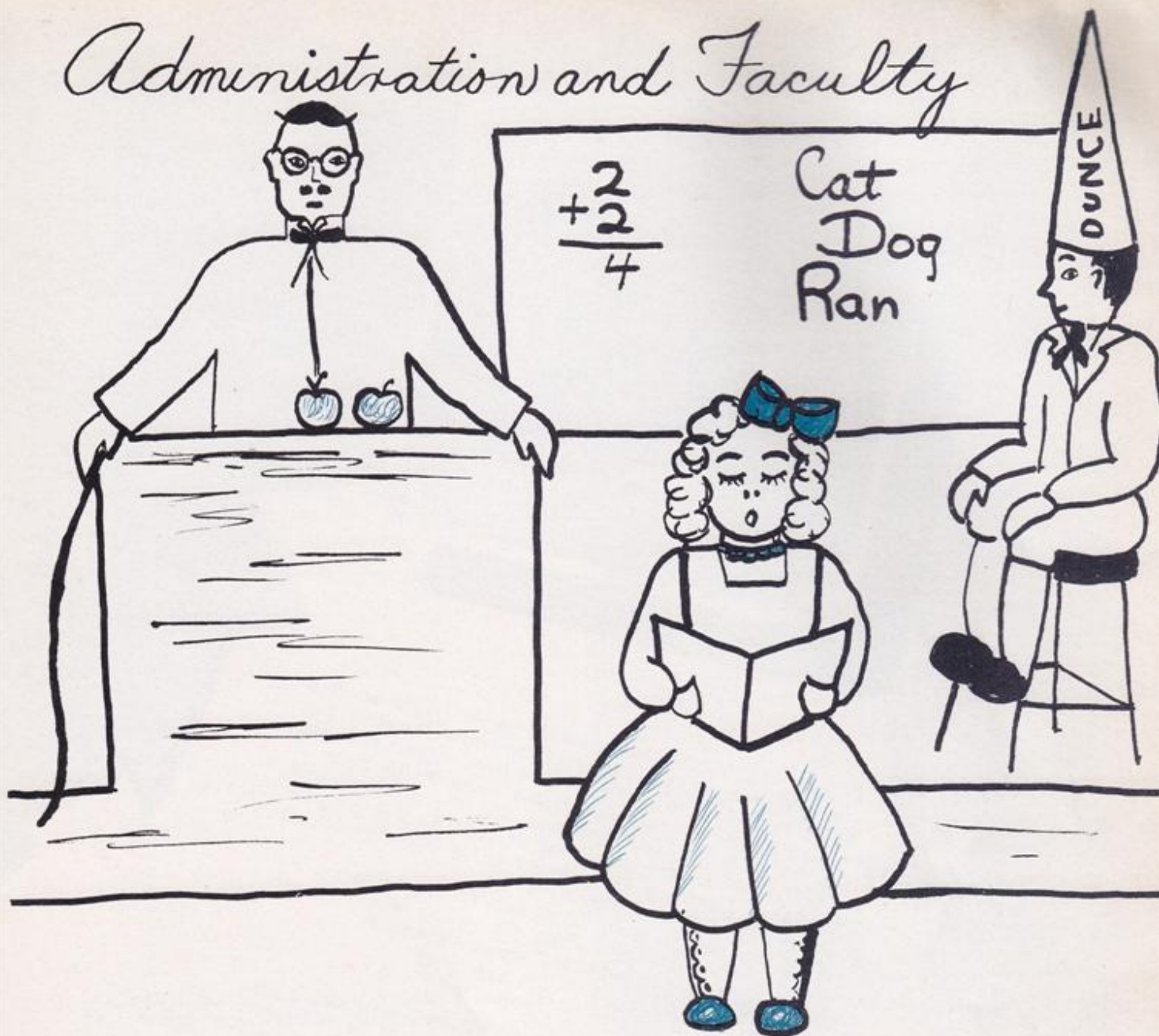


DEDICATION
