

This is the second consecutive CIC championship won by the squad and they should easily capture next year's contest.

Coach Ouverson was unhappy with the first nine total but commented that he was well satisfied with the 149 comeback made by the squad on the second nine.

### On To State Sectional

The Boone High golf squad started on a journey to the state championship May 9 by overpowering Hoover, Dowling and Carroll Kuemper at Carroll.

Two new records were set: low 9-hole total of 136 on out-of-town course, and low 18 hole total of 277 on out-of-town course.

Jeff Rees shot a 67 to capture medalist honors and Brad Post was 1 behind at 68. Doug Miller and Charles Updegraff tied with 71s.

It was a great day for golf, but Hoover, Dowling, and Kuemper could manage only 296, 302, and 307 respectively.

Boone and Hoover advance to district competition as well as Rees and Post individually at Boone on May 16.

### District

The golf squad qualified for the state meet by winning the district golf meet held here May 16. Ames was second, seven shots behind the 295 Toreador total.

Also qualifying individually were medalist Brad Post and runner-up Charles Updegraff.

There are 8 districts in Iowa and the winning and runner-up teams advance to the state tournament. Also, the medalist and runner-up medalist advance even if their team does not, so as to have a chance at becoming State High School Golf Champ.

The course was wet but the Toreadors carded a 72, 73, and pair of 75s to clinch the victory.

Not qualifying for the State meet were Hoover (324) and Marshalltown (336).

Boone set a new home course record, also, by shooting an even par 144 the back 9.

### STATE CHAMPS!!!!

Saturday, May 23, the Toreador golf team captured its first State High School Golf Championship in 24 years at the George Veenker Memorial Golf Course in Ames. Sixteen teams took part in the 18 hole contest.

Boone was on top with a 309, Waterloo Columbus second with a 318, and Dubuque Walhurt third with a 319.

Brad Post became the new State High School Golf Champ as he took medalist honors at 71. Dean Bakke was runner-up with a 73.

Second for Boone was Doug Miller with a 75, Jeff Rees was third with an 80 and Jeff Saggau was last but not least with an 83.

Boone averaged just over 77 although the course was in bad condition because of heavy rains a week before and wet conditions due to rain the night before. Boone had been the favorite and despite this added pressure, the Boone squad easily showed Iowa who had the best team in the state.
