## Prom 1971

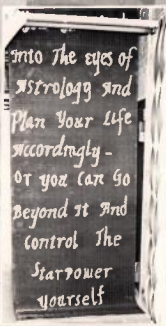

# Fall Track



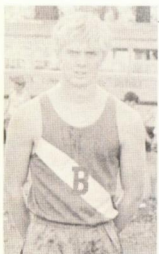
