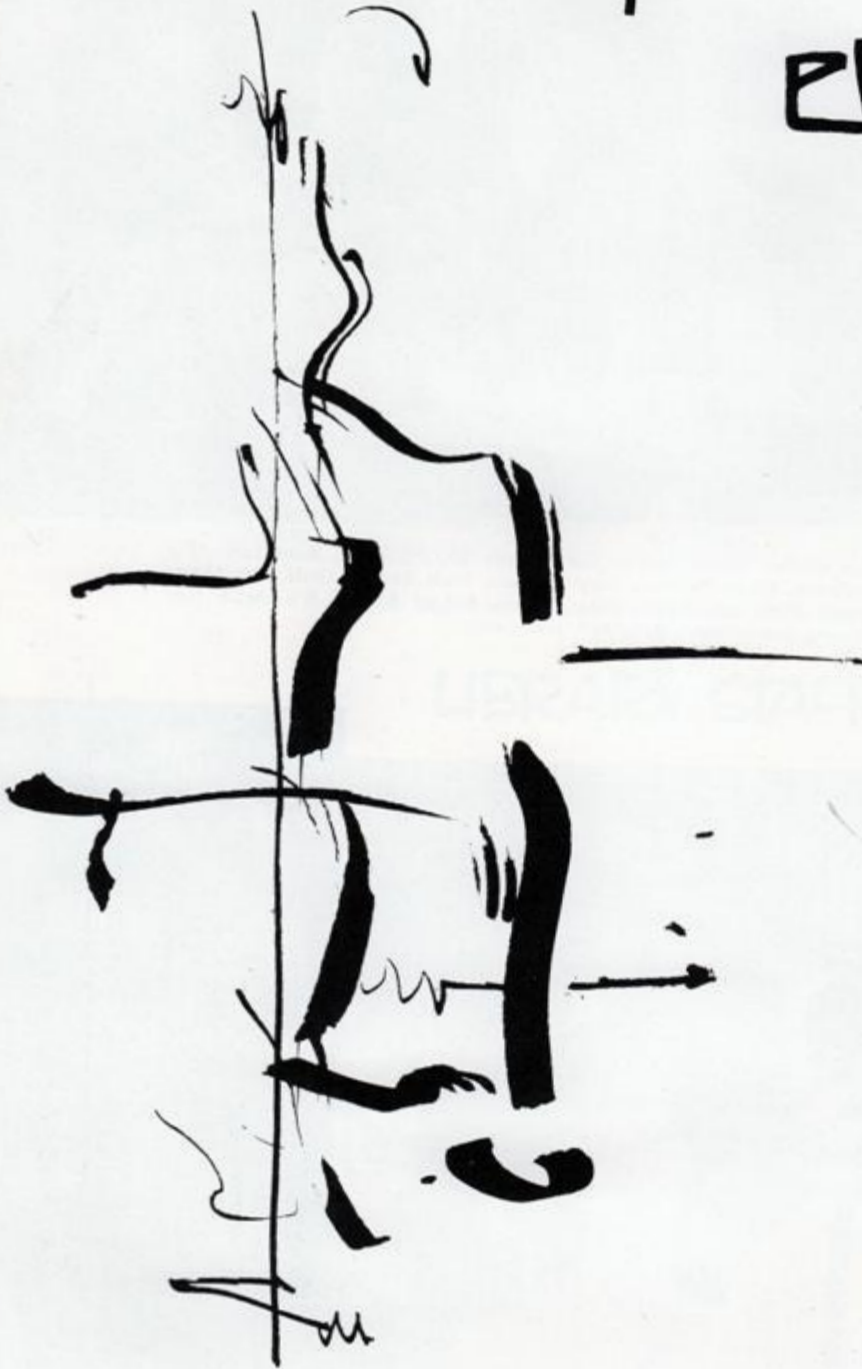


# special events

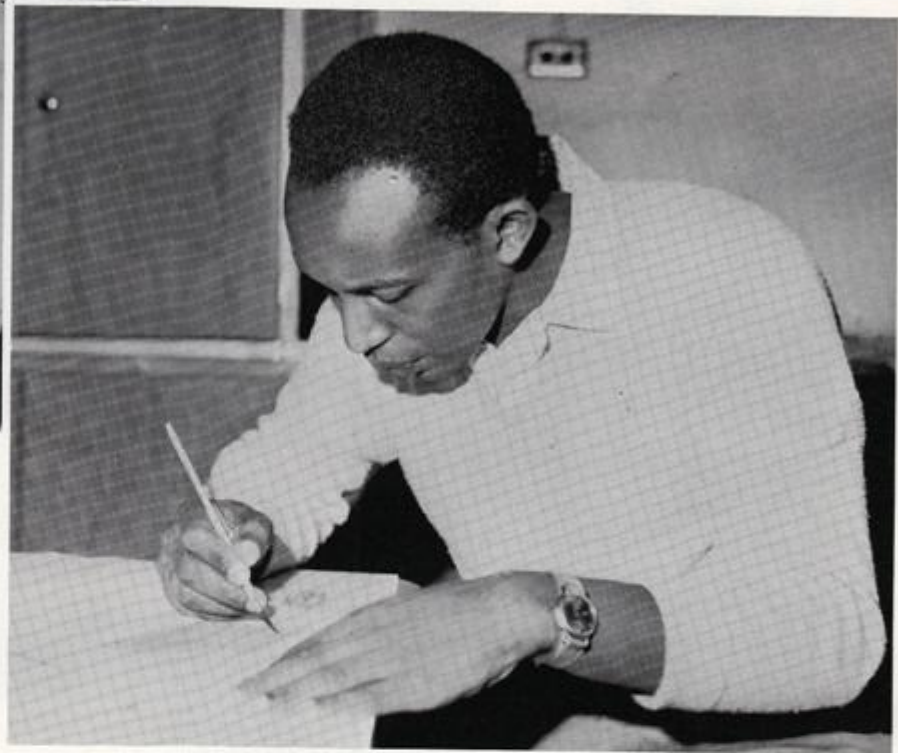
Many BJC students took advantage of the archery course offered first semester to last through the fall months; this was the first year for archery to be offered to BJC students.

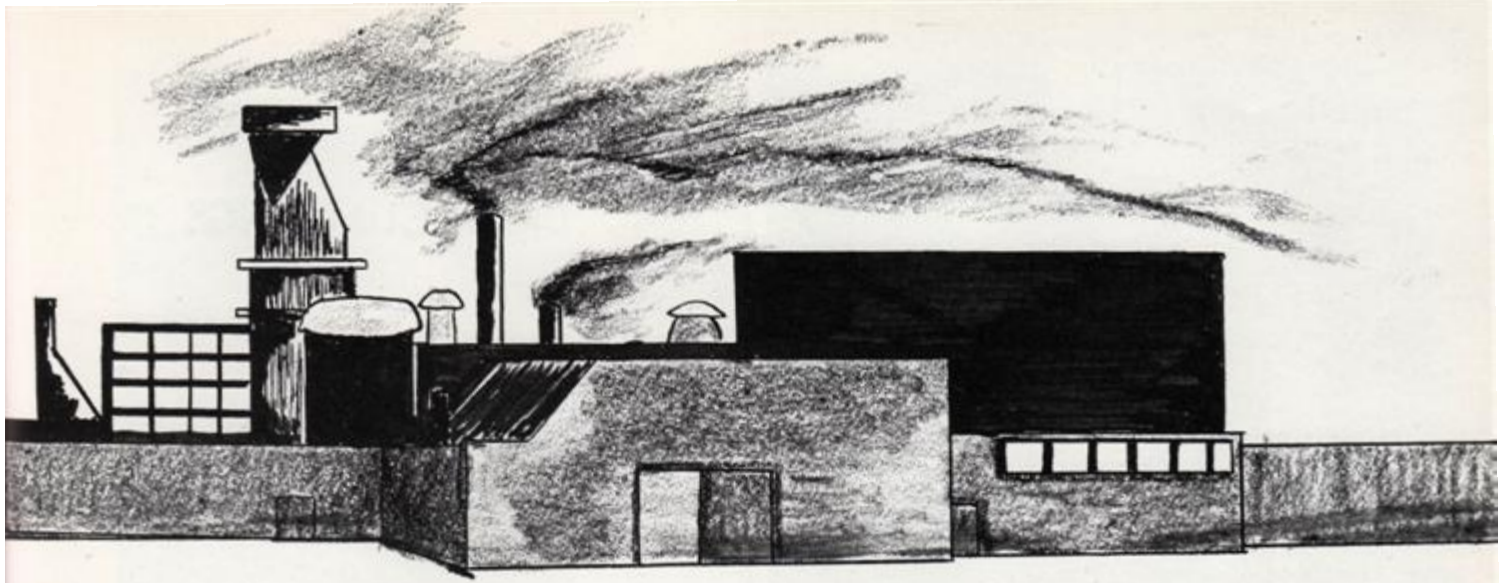
