As the bells tolled in September, 1946, eight of the present senior class----- Earl Brice, Colleen Bennett, Sue Casserly, Dan Garvey, Beth Fangman, Mike Stammeyer, Aaron Vest, and Delores Headley----filled the first grade desks of Sister Mary William James. Our liking to the rhythm band and marble games at recess started us on our twelve year climb.

In second grade we were greeted by Sister Mary Del Ray who prepared us for our First Holy Communion and taught us our numbers. Our class was increased by Pat Dittmer's and Pat Donovan's appearances.

Sister Mary Adele received our custody in third grade, when we were joined by Kay Turner and presented the memorable play of St. Bernadette. It was during the delightful but trying days of fourth grade that we tried and wore out several Sisters among whom were Sister Mary Rose Patrice, Sister Mary Cidgisman, and Sister Mary Jean Victor. It was also during this year that Delores Headley left to return the following fall.

Fifth grade saw Dan Garvey leave for three years and Aaron Vest leave for two and one-half years. Sister Mary Bertha instilled geography and the words of the 'Star Spangled Banner' into our minds.

Moving into the new school at mid-semester was the highlight of sixth grade. It was also during this year that Sister Mary Hilary taught many of our members the art of writing after school and Beth Fangman left to live in Fremont, Nebraska, for two years.

Pat Lacey's arrival and membership in the Civics Club marked seventh grade. It was through Sister Mary Ursulina's tireless efforts that we were prepared for entrance into high school.

The freshman initiation and prom will always be held and cherished as memorable events marking the year of our glorious entrance into high school. Dick Hare and Larry Ackerman joined our ranks. Sister Mary Virgine and Sister Mary St. David patiently taught us Latin and algebra. And it was during this outstanding year that Sister Mary Virgine instructed us as to the proper use of our vocal chords and we took part in the DYO music festival. And Father Phillips gave us religious instruction.

Again in tenth grade, the Sisters tried to pound the principles of geometry and second year Latin into our dense, uncomprehending intellects. Father Friedman taught us religion. From their perseverance and guidance we experienced the thrills of class day in Omaha, the banquet and prom, Vieshea, Washington D.C. trip, Mons. Ryan's Jubilee, and many other events which helped to mark our last days at Sacred Heart

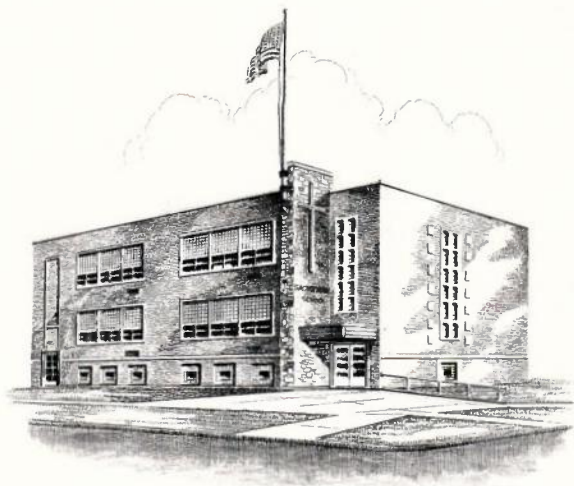

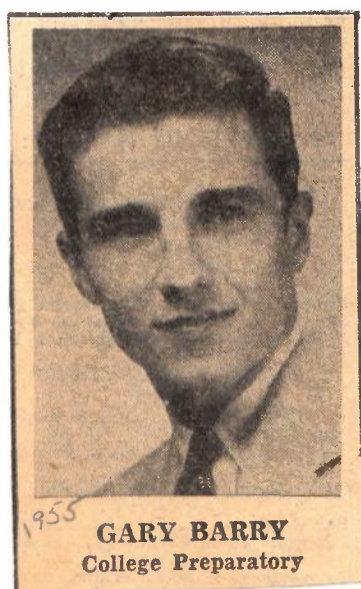

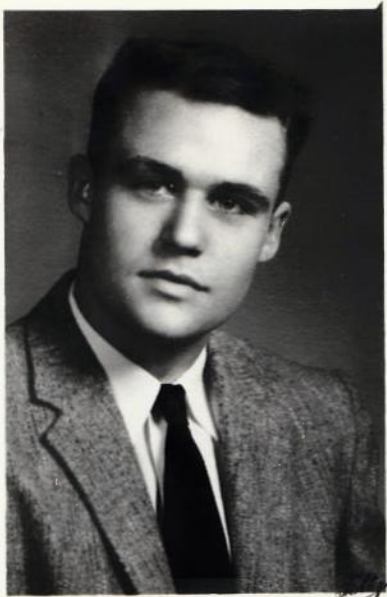
